The result for January–September 2022



Key figures

- Net sales increased and was EUR 79.0 million (EUR 62.0 million)
- EBITDA improved and was EUR 4.3 million (EUR 3.6 million)
- The operating result was EUR 0.1 million (EUR -0.8 million)
- Cash flow from operating activities was EUR 2.7 million (EUR 0.5 million)

Financing

- The Group's cash and cash equivalents at the end of September were EUR 6.5 million (EUR 7.6 million)
- At the end of the review period, the group had binding credit commitments of EUR 4.0 million, of which unused EUR 2.0 million and a subscription limit of USD 8.0 million, of which the unused portion was USD 7.5 million
- The Group's liquidity was at a good level at the end of the review period

Market situation

- The order book is at a very strong level (Net sales guidelines lifted on 25.10.)
- The direct effects of the Ukraine crisis on Componenta's operations are mild
- · The general availability of materials has improved
- The upward trend in purchase prices continued
- Uncertainties in the energy market have kept the price level of electrical energy very high and exceptionally volatile

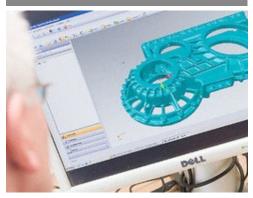

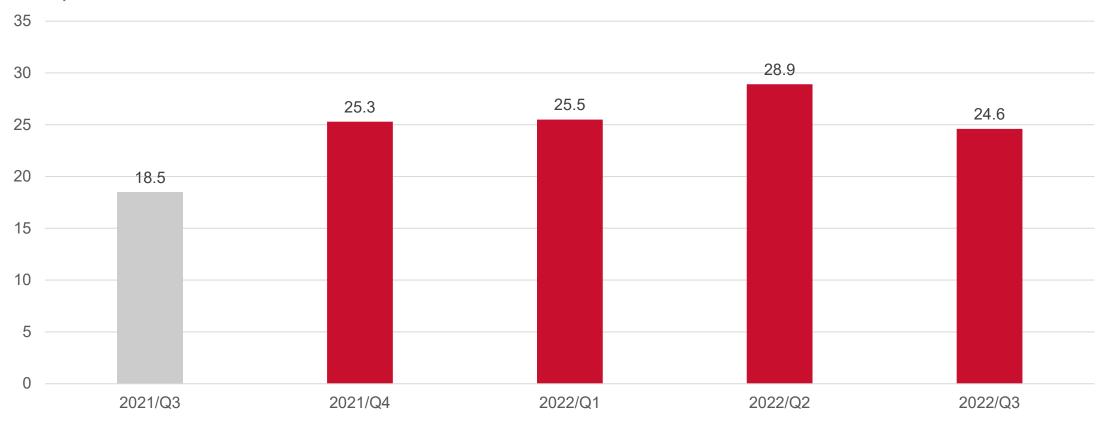

Net sales

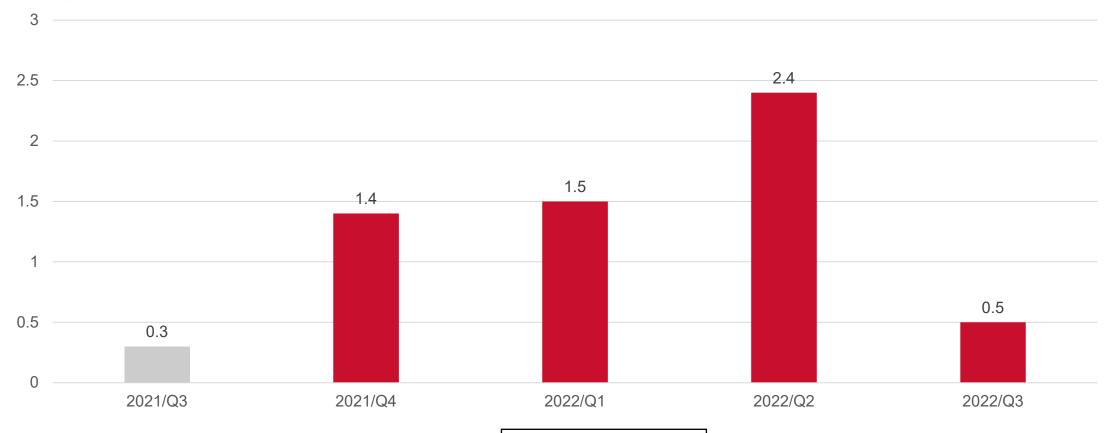

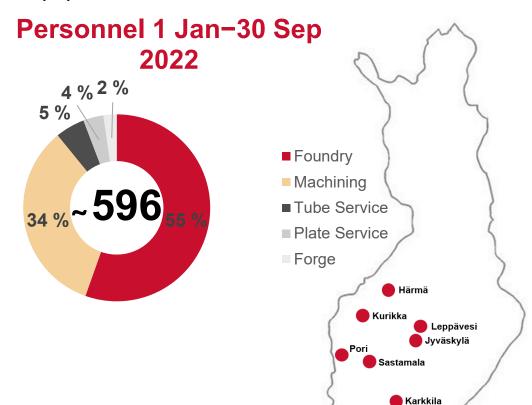

Componenta expects the net sales in 2022 to be EUR 105–110 million. EBITDA is expected to improve from the previous year.
